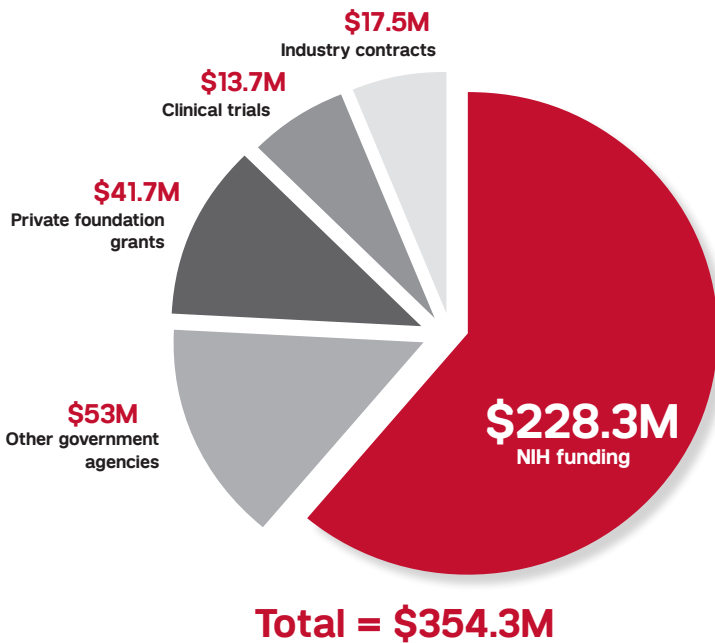

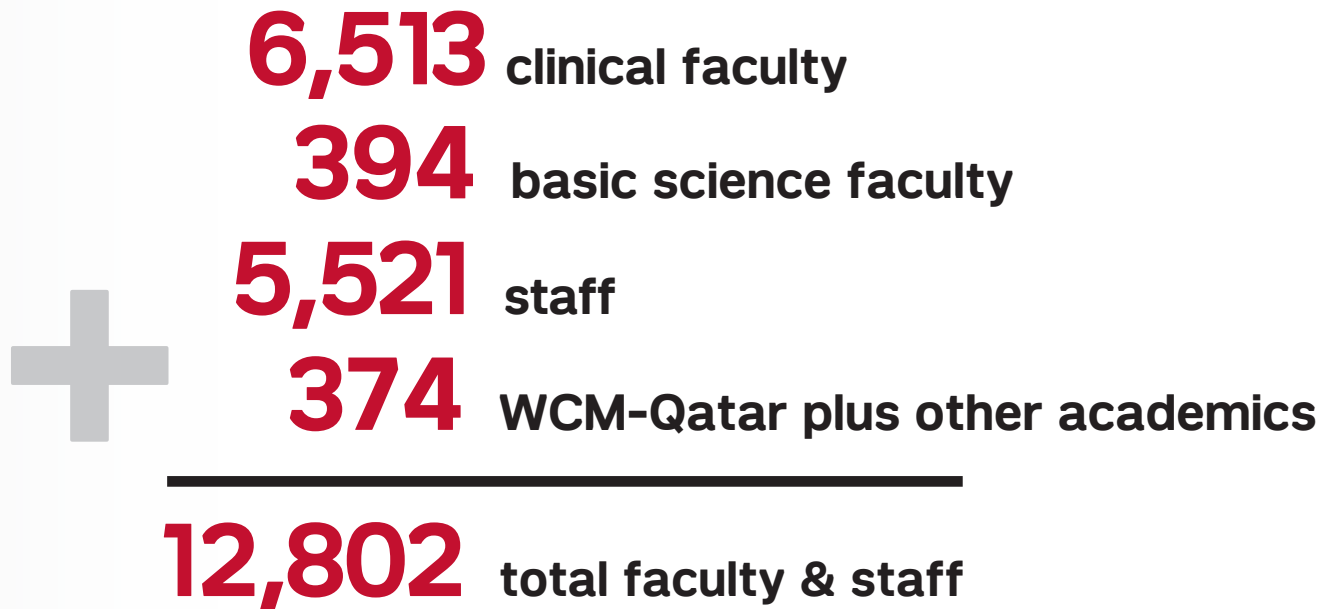

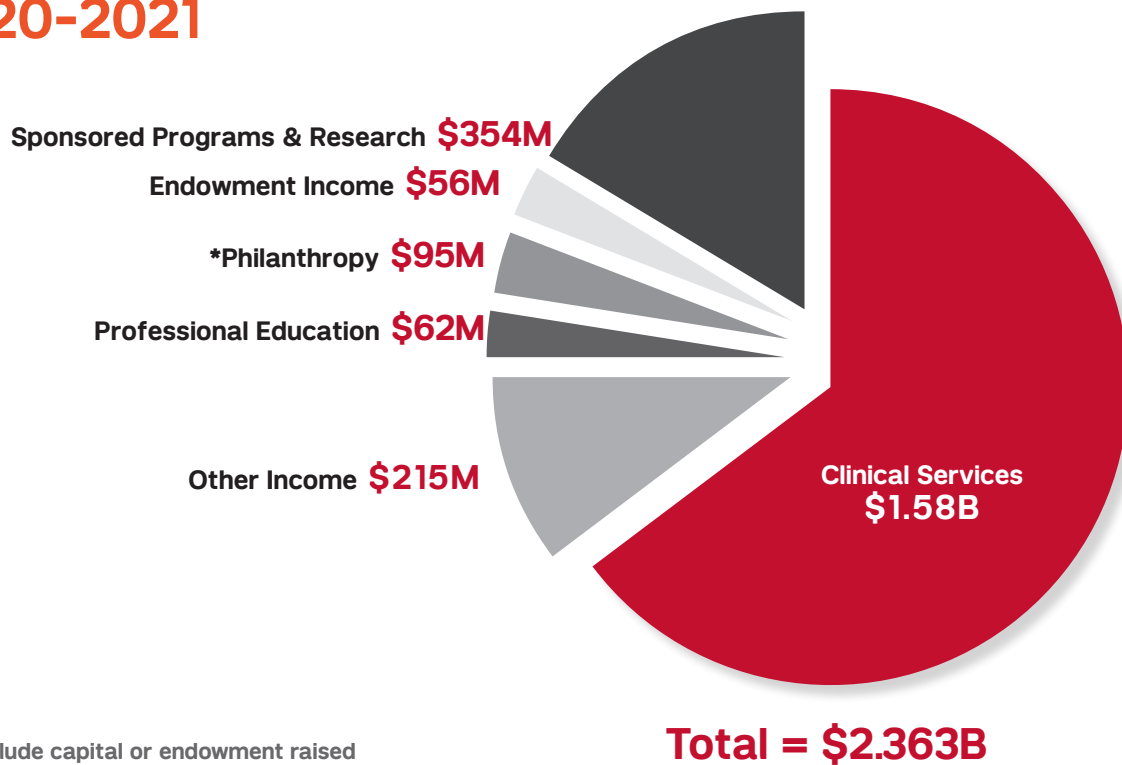
A three-part mission shapes Weill Cornell Medicine: exceptional care, research and education.
